Peppermint Grove Heritage Tour

The Grove Library has developed a digital heritage tour for the beautiful suburb of Peppermint Grove with generous funding from the Department of Culture and the Arts. The trail is a "virtual" tour which is accessible via a mobile device such as a smartphone or tablet with internet connection and utilises GPS Wayfinding technology.

The content has been researched by Dr Sue Graham-Taylor, drawing on the archives of The Grove Library and Presbyterian Ladies College.

Acoustiguide Australia has produced the final product with professional graphics and narration.

Those taking the tour will be able to view historic images and listen to narration about points of interest viewable along the trail. The physical tour has been designed to take around an hour and a half to complete, in a circuit from The Grove; a pleasant outdoor activity for residents and visitors of Peppermint Grove.
